



Bib pickup: Saturday, May 29
Race date: Sunday, May 30, 2027

Not everyone has the chance to train in the mountains, so toeing the start line of a trail run with elevation gain can sometimes be scary. That's why the Marathon-eXpérience was born, to allow everyone to come and gain eXperience in the mountains. No minimum level is required, but a good dose of motivation will get you to reach the finish line!



Registration and key dates

- **1st to 7 October: pre-registration** with credit card pre-authorization – the registration fee will only be charged if you are selected
- **8 to 10 October: selection of runners.** To confirm your registration, there's nothing you need to do — you'll be notified and charged directly via your credit card. Registration is non-refundable ([see full rules](#)).

Key dates to remember:

- **Before end of November:** SAS assignment
- **15 April at 9:00 AM:** deadline for reselling and transferring your bib
- **16 April at 9:00 AM:** deadline for changing your SAS number; bib numbers assigned
- **From 23 April to 21 May :** book your bib pickup time slot on your personal race profile
- **Before 16 May:** PPS number or license number to provide on your personal runner profile

Bibs

Bibs MUST be collected the day before the race (Saturday, May 29) and in person.
There will be a front bib and a back bib, so 2 bibs to have during the race.

A runner may be disqualified if assistants/spectators do not follow the rules (parking, restricted zones, no-assistance zones, walking in the alpine pastures...).

Km 19 and 1,380m D+: Life Base « Semnoz »

Accessible by MaXi-Car (bus option), by bike (a 1st^{category} climb, 20km of ascent) or by car (350 parking spaces)



WATER in heatwave

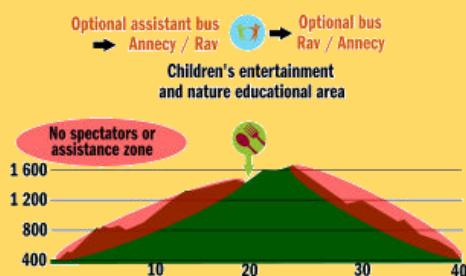
KM 33 – 1,625m D+



Finish at MaXi-Village Annecy : 100km / 5500m D+ and 5500m D-

Finisher pack

It must be collected immediately after crossing the finish line.
It will not be possible to come back for it later, nor to exchange it.
