



A 100% men's race

Bib pickup: Friday, May 28

Race date: Saturday, May 29, 2027

*With a start in Semnoz and a finish in Annecy, the Quart de tOur will be a « **Negative Trail** » since the course will be mostly downhill.*



Registration and key dates

- **1st to 7 October: pre-registration** with credit card pre-authorization – the registration fee will only be charged if you are selected
- **8 to 10 October: selection of runners.** To confirm your registration, there's nothing you need to do — you'll be notified and charged directly via your credit card. Registration is non-refundable ([see full rules](#)).

Key dates to remember:

- **Before end of November:** SAS assignment
- **15 April at 9:00 AM :** deadline for reselling and transferring your bib
- **16 April at 9:00 AM:** deadline for changing your SAS number; bib numbers assigned
- **23 April at 9:00 AM :** deadline to purchase the bus option
- **From 23 April to 21 May :** book your bib pickup time slot on your personal race profile
- **Before 16 May :** PPS number or license number to provide on your personal runner profile

Bibs

Bibs MUST be collected the day before the race (Friday, May 28) and in person.

There will be a front bib and a back bib, so 2 bibs to have during the race.



Bus from Annecy to the start in Semnoz

- Runner bus to the race start: optional, €10
- Booking to be made in your personal account before 23 April at 9:00 AM.

- Departure at 7:30 AM from [avenue Pierre de Coubertin](#), Annecy

Rankings and podium

- **Rankings:** 5 top men and 5 top women awarded
- **Awarded categories:** : 1st of each category U20, U23, Seniors, M0, M1, M2, M3, M4, M5, M6, M7 (please come to the info point at least 2h after your finish to collect your prize)



Assistants

A runner may be disqualified if assistants/spectators do not follow the rules (parking, restricted zones, no-assistance zones, walking in the alpine pastures...).

Course description

Start: Life Base « Semnoz »

Accessible by MaXi-Car (bus option), by bike (a 1st-^{category} climb, 20km of ascent) or by car - 350 parking spaces

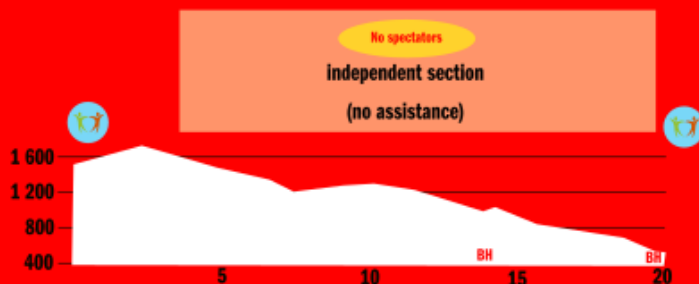
There is no aid station or water point on this course.



Finish: approx 19km / 410m D+ and 1450m D-

Finisher pack

It must be collected immediately after crossing the finish line.
It will not be possible to come back for it later, nor to exchange it.
