



**Bib pickup: Friday, May 28**  
**Race date: Saturday, May 29, 2027**  
**Relay legs: 46km + 39km + 15km**

A relay team can be made up of **2 or 3 runners** who complete the tOur of Lake Annecy, through the mountains, on forest trails. Water points will be available in some valleys, but no water resupply will be provided in mountainous areas. **Semi-autonomy** is therefore mandatory.

In total, **3 light aid stations (RAV Light)** and **2 life bases** will be available to you.

Teams of 2 or 3 relay runners may swap runners **only** at the two life bases, located in **Doussard** and **Semnoz**.

If a runner misses a cut-off time or withdraws from the race, **the whole team will be declared DNF** and will not be allowed to resume the event.



## Registration and key dates

- **1<sup>st</sup> to 7 October: pre-registration** with credit card authorization – the registration fee will only be charged if you are selected
- **8 to 10 October: relay team selection.** To confirm your registration, you don't need to do anything; you will be notified and charged directly via your card. Registration is non-refundable ([see full rules](#)).

### Changing a teammate:

To be done directly via your personal account:

- Before **April 20** to have your bibs with the correct first name.
- Change still possible **until May 15**, without the first name being updated on the bib.
- After this date (**May 15**), it will no longer be possible to change the name.

### **Key dates to remember:**

- **Before end of November:** SAS assignment
- **April 16 at 9:00 AM:** deadline to change SAS number, bib number assignment
- **From April 23 to May 21 :** booking your bib pickup time slot on the team captain's personal profile
- **Before May 16:** PPS or license number to be provided on your personal runner profile

### Parking to reach the MaXi-Village

Several free parking areas are located on [Avenue du Petit-Port](#) (between 2 and 3.5 km from the village).



### Bibs

Bibs MUST be picked up in person the day before the race (Friday, May 28) (at least one team member with original ID documents for all teammates).

There will be one team bib to pass on (timing chip), plus each runner will have their own personal bib. So 2 bibs to have during the race.



### Start location

- The SAS will open 20 minutes before their start time
- Other waves (solo runners) will start between 1:20 and 3:20



### Rankings and podium

- **Ranking:** A single overall ranking whether you are 2 or 3 relay runners.
- **Categories :** Men, Women, Mixed (at least one man or one woman)
- **Podium:** there will be no podium for this race since it is a solidarity relay for the region



### Assistant

A runner may be disqualified if their support assistant/spectators/relay teammates do not follow the rules (parking, restricted areas, no-assistance zones, walking on alpine pastures...).

## Relay leg details

### 1<sup>st</sup> leg: approx. 46km / 2900m D+ and 2900m D-

Including the first 20 kilometers with restrictions:

- Poles are forbidden – they must be attached to your pack, not held in hand!
  - Silent zones are in place and spectators/support crew are forbidden
- Penalties range from a 1-hour time penalty to immediate disqualification if not respected.

### KM 46 and 2,900m D+: “Doussard” Life Base, runner change possible

Accessible by MaXi-Car (bus option), by bike (cycle path along the lake), or by car – 350 parking spaces  
Requirement to carry 1,5 liters of water with you

### 2<sup>nd</sup> leg: approx. 39km / 2300m D+ and 1300m D-

### Km 85 and 5,300m D+: Life Base “Semnoz” runner change possible

Accessible by MaXi-Car (bus option), by bike (a category 1<sup>st</sup> climb, 20km ascent) or by car – 350 parking spaces

Requirement to carry 1 liter of water with you

### 3<sup>rd</sup> leg: approx. 15km / 200m D+ and 1200m D-

No aid station on this section, no water



### Finish MaXi-Village Annecy: 100km / 5500m D+ and 5500m D-

Relay runner: 150m before the finish, there is an entry SAS so your whole team crosses the finish line together. To access it: bib required for everyone.

## Finisher pack

It must be collected immediately after the finish line.  
It will not be possible to come back for it afterward, nor to exchange it.
