



Bib pickup: Friday, May 28
Race date: Saturday, May 29, 2027

*The tOur of Lake Annecy takes place through the mountains, on forest trails. Water points will be available in some valleys, but no water resupply will be provided in mountainous areas. **Semi-autonomy** is therefore mandatory.*

*In total, **3 light aid stations (RAV Light)** and **2 life bases** will be available to you.*



Registration and key dates

- **1st to 7 October: pre-registration** with credit card authorization – the registration fee will only be charged if you are selected
- **8 to 10 October : runner selection.** To confirm your registration, you don't need to do anything ; you will be notified and charged directly via your card. Registration is non-refundable ([see full rules](#)).

Key dates to remember:

- **Before end of November:** SAS assignment
- **April 15 at 9:00 AM:** deadline for resale and transfer of your bib
- **April 16 at 9:00 AM:** deadline to change SAS number, bib number assignment
- **April 23 at 9:00 AM :** deadline to purchase the drop bag option
- **From April 23 to May 21 :** booking your bib pickup time slot on your personal profile
- **Before May 16:** PPS or license number to be provided on your personal runner profile

Bibs

Bibs MUST be picked up in person the day before the race (Friday, May 28).

There will be a front bib and a back bib, so 2 bibs to have during the race.



Drop bag at Doussard (optional)

- A drop bag available at mid-race, optional for €12.
- Booking to be done on your personal account before April 23 at 9:00 AM.
- Bag measuring 45x30x30 cm provided by the organization

Rankings and podium

- **Ranking:** top 7 men and top 7 women awarded (with a cash prize)
- **Award categories :** 1st place in each category: U23, Seniors, M0, M1, M2, M3, M4, M5, M6, M7 (come to the info point at least 2h after your finish to collect your prize)
- All runners who withdraw at Doussard or after will be reclassified as MaXi-Challenger



Assitant

A runner may be disqualified if their support assistant/spectators do not follow the rules (parking, restricted areas, no-assistance zones, walking on alpine pastures...).

Course description

1st section: approx. 46km / 2900m D+ and 2900m D-

Including the first 20 kilometers with restrictions :

- Poles are forbidden – they must be attached to your pack, not held in hand !
 - Silent zones are in place and spectators/support crew are forbidden
- Penalties range from a 1-hour time penalty to immediate disqualification if not respected.

Km 85 and 5,300m D+: Life Base “Semnoz”

Accessible by MaXi-Car (bus option) or by bike (a category 1st climb, 20km ascent) or by car – 350 parking spaces

Requirement to carry 1 liter of water with you

3rd section: approx. 15km / 200m D+ and 1200m D-

No aid station on this section, no water



Finish MaXi-Village Annecy: 100km / 5500m D+ and 5500m D-

Finisher pack

It must be collected immediately after the finish line.

It will not be possible to come back for it afterward, nor to exchange it.
